The **Training in Oncology Population Sciences** (TOPS) T32 program at the Dana-Farber/Harvard Cancer Center will train postdoctoral fellows to conduct research at the T3 and T4 interface to translate knowledge from the lab into practice and population health to reduce the burden of cancer.

About the TOPS Program

- TOPS Fellows conduct **T3/T4, population sciences, and health services** research.
- TOPS Fellows receive a stipend, coursework tuition, travel allowance, & budget for research-related expenses.
- TOPS Fellows are required to participate in all 3 components of the program:
 - (1) Mentored research experience
 - (2) Didactic learning and coursework, including the HSPH's Summer Program in Clinical Effectiveness
 - (3) Professional development, including participating in the TOPS seminar series
